## 2023-0-05 ORDINANCE

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, IN PART, AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "ORDINANCE REQUIRING DISPLAY OF E911 ADDRESSES IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS" WHICH WAS ADOPTED JUNE 8, 2004 (Ordinance No. 2004-O-03)

WHEREAS, the Putnam County Board has a responsibility to promote the health and well-being of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Putnam County Board has heretofore adopted an Ordinance to regulate the display of 911 addresses in unincorporated areas; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the County Board of Putnam that there is an error in SECTION TWO B of the Ordinance Requiring Display of E911 Addresses In Unincorporated Areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF PUTNAM COUNTY, ILLINOIS, NOW IN REGULAR SESSION, THAT THE AMENDMENT IN PART OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "ORDINANCE REQUIRING DISPLAY OF E911 ADDRESSES IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS" IS HEREBY ADOPTED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section TWO B is amended to read as follows:

All identification numbers shall be made of white reflective material. All white reflective numbers shall measure between two and one-half (2 ½) inches and three (3) inches in height. Further, said identification numbers shall be displayed on a contrasting green background.

2. This amendment to the Ordinance requiring the display of E911 addresses in unincorporated areas shall be effective immediately.
